Tournament Rules

- Players will start with 15,000 in tournament chips.
- A single ante will be paid from the big blind for each hand. The ante is paid before the big blind. The ante will not reduce.
- On-Site Registration and unlimited Re-Entries will be available until the start of level 13 for each flight of this event.
- Players are allowed unlimited re-entries for each flight, but must bust-out or forfeit chips prior to registering for that specific flight.
- Tournament Supervisor must approve all forfeiture of chips.
- Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- Day 1 Levels: Will last 30 minutes each. Day 2 Levels: Will last 40 minutes each. Final Table levels: 40 minutes each.
- 10% of each flight's field, rounded up, will advance to day 2. Day 2 will play until conclusion or 3AM. Players will have an option to complete the tournament with Tournament Directors approval.
- A redraw will occur at the end of day 1. A redraw will also occur at 27 and 10 players or at Tournament Directors discretion.
- Players surviving more than one Day 1 flight will carry their largest chip stack for play on day 2 and the duration of the tournament.
- Players surviving more than one Day 1 flight will receive a \$1,500 cash payout for the lesser multiple chip stack. The lesser stack will also be pulled from play. Players can receive a maximum of (8) \$1,500 Multi Stack Cash Payouts. After all multi stack payouts have been awarded the remaining prize pool will be distributed to all players returning for play on Day 2 using a Pay Chart Multi Stack Payout.
- All players who make Day 2 are in the money. **All Multi Stack payouts will be pulled from the prize pool prior to posting the day 2 payouts.**
- Tournament Directors Decisions are final and without recourse.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It is each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- Winners will be paid in casino chips. All tax laws foreign and domestic apply. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
- Seating may be limited for this event.
- TDA rules apply. Tournament Directors decisions are final and without recourse.
- Must be 21 or older to play. Must have a 24K Select Players card to participate in the tournament.
- Tournament prize pools may be modified if all remaining players unanimously agree.
- \$155 will go into the prize pool. \$31 is the registration fee. \$14 will go into the staff pool.
